

There are four **MAPPA** areas in South Yorkshire: **Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham and Sheffield.**



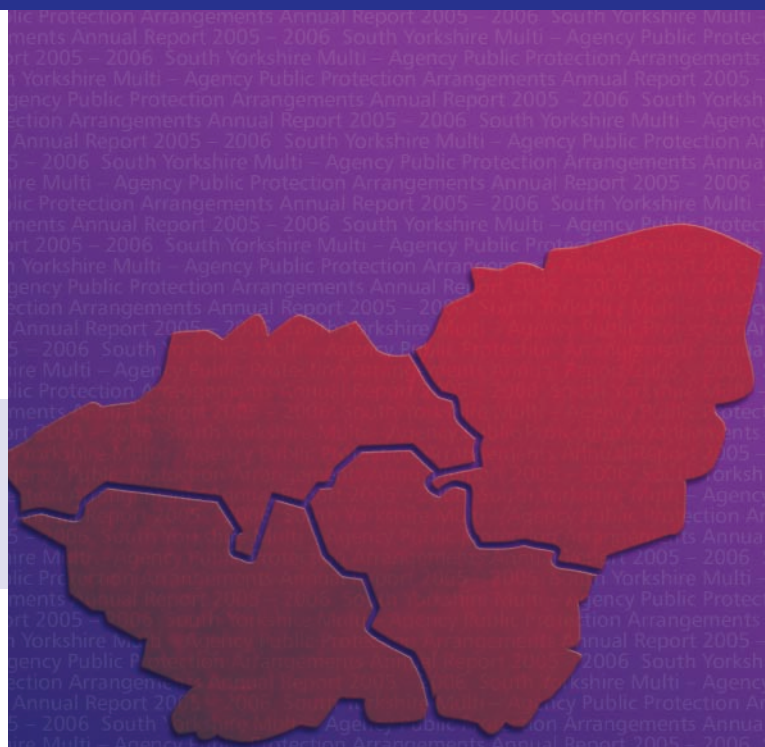
The police, probation and prison services all have MAPPA representatives. Members of the general public can ask for details at any local police station or probation office.

Managing risk through MAPPA  
(Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements)



## What is MAPPA?

MAPPA stands for Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements, which first came into being in 2001 in England and Wales. It provides a statutory basis for the work of the police, the probation and prison services who undertake to protect the public from violent and sexual offenders.

## What can MAPPA do?

We identify, assess and risk manage relevant offenders and, using the multi-agency approach, exchange and share information to help us manage that risk as successfully as possible and to protect the public.



MAPPA can advise particular agencies of action they might take to improve public protection and effectively manage risk in individual cases.

Usually the agencies present will agree a range of measures, which collectively form a public protection plan.
