What is **MAPPA**?

MAPPA stands for Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements, which first came into being in 2001 in England and Wales. It provides a statutory basis for the work of the police, the probation and prison services who undertake to protect the public from violent and sexual offenders.

What can **MAPPA** do?

We identify, assess and risk manage relevant offenders and, using the multi-agency approach, exchange and share information to help us manage that risk as successfully as possible and to protect the public.

MAPPA can advise particular agencies of action they might take to improve public protection and effectively manage risk in individual cases.

Usually the agencies present will agree a range of measures, which collectively form a public protection plan.

2. Category 2 MAPPA offenders: Violent Offenders and Other Sexual Offenders (V&OS)

vi) The number of violent and other sexual offenders (as defined by Section 327 (3), (4) and (5) of the Criminal Justice Act 2003) living in your area between 1 April 2006 and 31 March 2007. **444**

3. Category 3 MAPPA offenders: Other Offenders (OthO)

vii) The number of 'other offenders' (as defined by Section 325 (2)(b) of the Criminal Justice Act 2003) between 1 April 2006 and 31 March 2007. **82**

4. Offenders Managed Through Level Three (MAPPP) & Level Two (local inter-agency management)

(viii) Identify how many MAPPA offenders in each of the three Categories (i.e. (1) RSOs, (2) V&O and (3) OthO above) have been managed through the MAPPP (Level Three) and through local inter-agency risk management (Level Two) between 1 April 2006 and 31 March 2007.

(c) Were charged with a serious sexual or violent offence? Level Three 1; Level Two 2.
